


THE PUBLIC PROCUREMENT ACT

The Public Procurement (Domestic Margin of Preference) Order, 2019

In exercise of the powers conferred on the Minister by regulation 44 of the Public Procurement Regulations, 2018, by virtue of section 60(1) (e) and (j) of the Public Procurement Act, and every other power hereunto enabling, the following Order is hereby made:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Procurement (Domestic Margin of Preference) Order, 2019.
2. A national bidder utilizing domestic content in the supply of goods, the carrying out of works or the provision of services is entitled to the benefit of a domestic margin of preference in accordance with paragraph 3.
3. In evaluating bids made by national bidders, a procuring entity shall apply a domestic margin of preference of 20% on the criterion of bid price in respect of bids which demonstrate the use of domestic content of a minimum threshold of 35%.
