NOTICE: REPEAL OF REQUIREMENT TO NOTIFY THE CPPPO

Please be advised that Section 44(8) of the Public Procurement Act, 2015, which previously required procuring entities to notify the Chief Public Procurement Policy Officer prior to requesting an extension of bid validity, has been repealed.

This change is pursuant to the enactment of the **Public Procurement (Amendment) Act, 2025**, which came into effect on **March 26, 2025**. As a result, procuring entities are no longer required to submit such notifications as a precondition for extending the bid validity period.
